Other reminders:

Please remember that earrings must not be worn for PE/Games lessons and during any sporting after school clubs. They need to be removed completely, children are no longer allowed to put tape around them. Children who wear earrings will not be able to take part in practical lessons, but may be able to take on the role of umpire, referee or coach where appropriate. The guidance from Cambridgeshire County Council explains that: 'The reason not to wear earrings (or any jewellery) is that it can lead to injury for the wearer and for others in the class and it is the teachers' duty of care that must apply here. The reason is both about the tearing of the ear lobe, but also the post of the earring going into the neck which is where the brachial nerve is running directly to the brain. This is also national policy from the Association of PE (AfPE).'

We recommend that children do not wear earrings at all on the days when the class has PE. If you child's ears have been pierced within the last 6 weeks and it is not possible to remove them yet, your child will not be able to take part in the practical activities in PE but may be able to act as a coach or referee.
