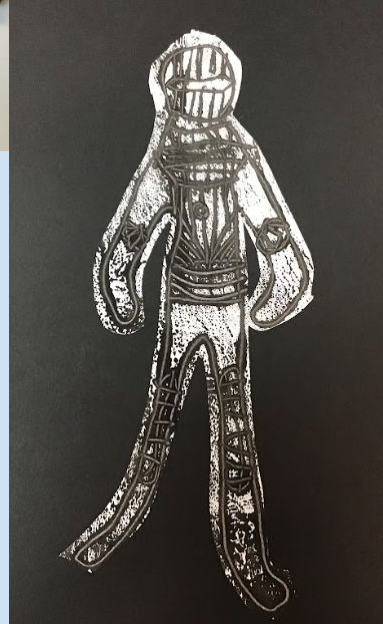
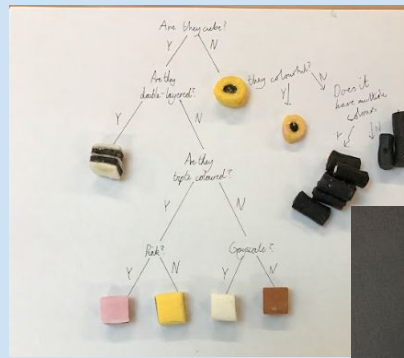
Last week in Year 4:

In Year 4, we have been learning about how different religions pray.



Last week in Year 6:

In Science, we started a new topic on classification. The children created their own classification examples using liquorice allsorts. They asked yes/no questions to help structure the different 'branches' and mapped this out on paper using felt pens.



The children have created knights using a form of printmaking called 'monoprinting'. They even cut them out and mounted these independently. We will display these in our classrooms.

Last week in Nursery:

We read Goldilocks and the Three Bears. The children have enjoyed retelling the story in the book nook with puppets and props. We have been ordering objects by size and playing 3 not 3 to develop our skills of recognising amounts without the need to count one to one.



We have been observing the growth of our spring bulbs outside. The children looked closely to explore differences in petal and leaf shape and colour. We have frog spawn in Nursery! The children are eagerly awaiting the emergence of tadpoles as we observe the life cycle process.

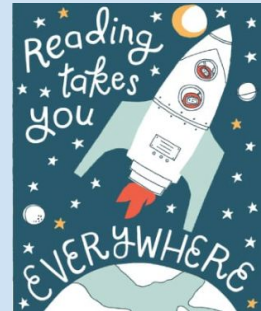
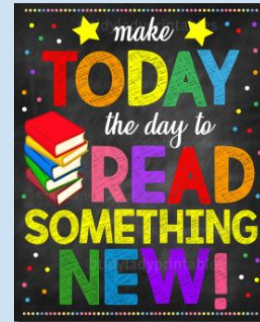
Brilliant Books:

Class 4 love this story, not least because at the end it teaches you how to make pasta!



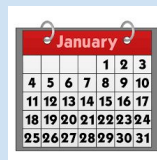
Have you read....?
