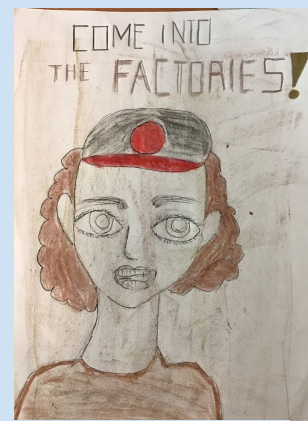
In Science, we have been learning about the parts of a flower. We dissected tulips and identified the sepal, petals, pistil and stamen.



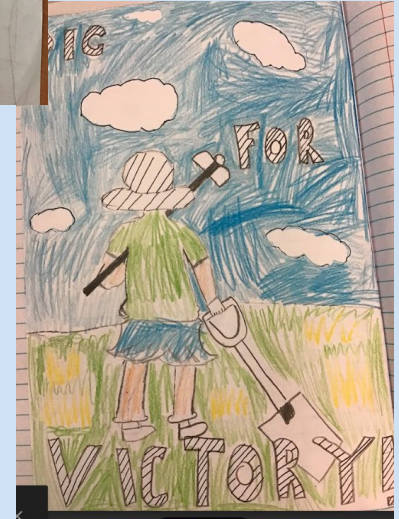


Last week in Year 6:

KS2 Sports Day:

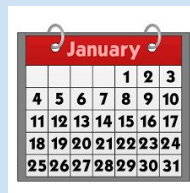
As the KS2 Sports Day is competitive between teams, children are allowed to wear a top that is the same colour as their school team on the day.
