day.










Last week in Year 5:



Year 5 have been experimenting with changing circuits in Science. We have been finding out what can make a bulb brighter or dimmer.






Best attendance last week: congratulations to Class 6 with 87% and Class 12 with 93%. Our whole school target is 97%.
