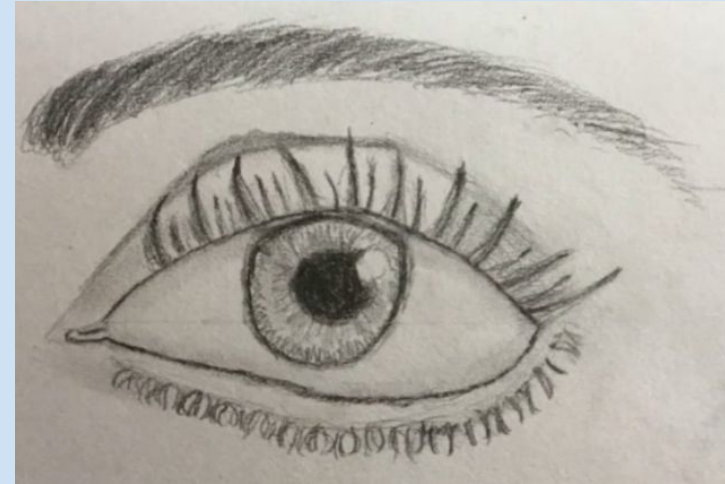
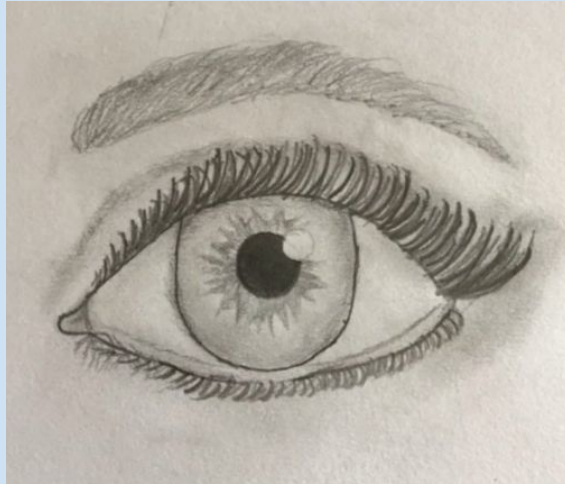
The school and nursery will be closed on Monday 19th September as a bank holiday has been announced for the day of the state funeral.
