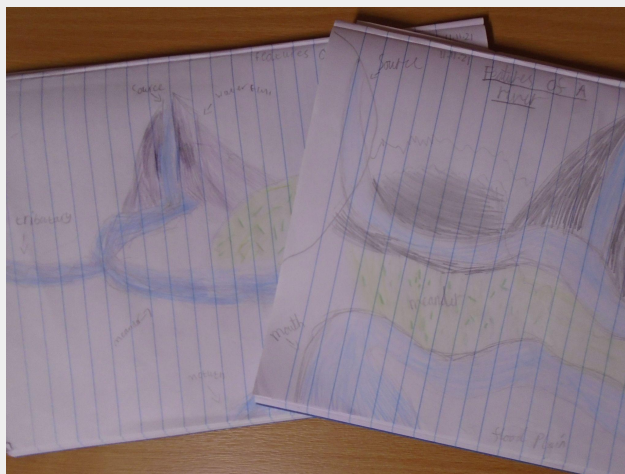
Last week in Reception:
