This week at Cavalry:

- This week Year 5 have started an exciting new project called 'Bits & Bytes'. Each week this term they will be working with a team from 20Twenty and having the opportunity to problem, solve and design with technology and robotics. This week their challenge was to make the tallest paper tower possible. The project will culminate in a 'robot wars' activity!
- In Year 3, science lessons have focused on different types of rocks. The children learnt about how sedimentary, igneous and metamorphic rocks are formed and modelled an example of this using Starburst sweets. Look out for photos on our social media feed!
- For Year 1, activities this week have centred on the story 'Handa's Surprise'. The children have been tasting fruits and finding out about hot countries in the world. They have also made mud huts and rainmakers.
- Class 13 have also seen the start of a new project this week. Working with 20Twenty again, the children have been split into three rock bands. This week they tried out the instruments, invented a name for their band and started work on a piece of their choice. In December there will be a 'battle of the bands', where parents and other classes will be able to listen to them perform. In the Spring term, this project will run for Class 14.
