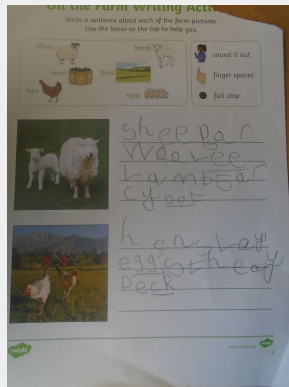


## Last week in Year 4:
