

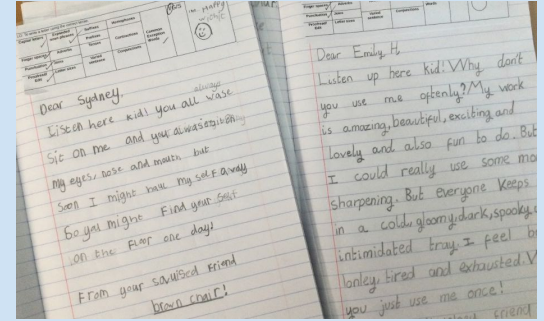

This week in year 4, we have been drawing our own fish! We had a go using pencil last week, and this week created our artwork using silver and gold pens.

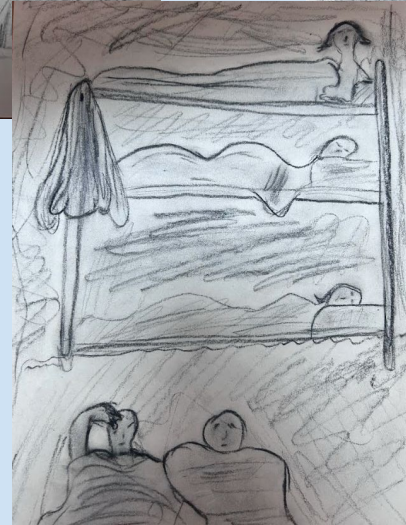
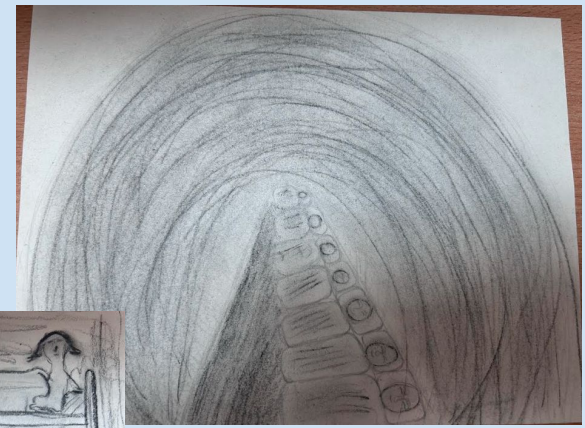
Miss Bourlet and Miss Hunter think they look great!

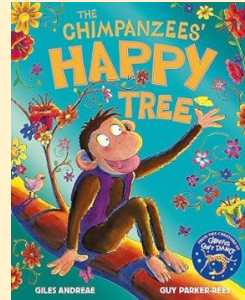

Class 6 have enjoyed reading this as a class reader together. C6 would you recommend it to a friend? Why?

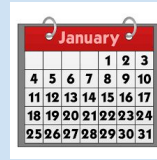
