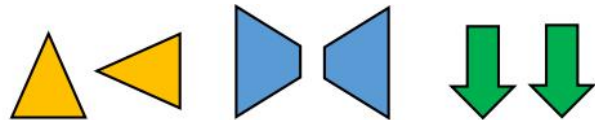

Draw what each shape will look like once it has turned:

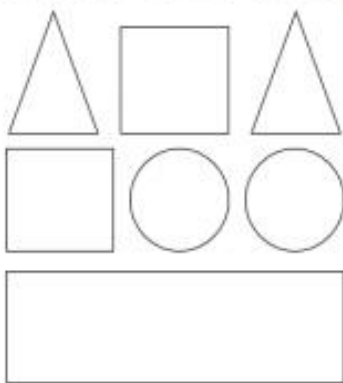
- A quarter turn
