Last week in Year 3:

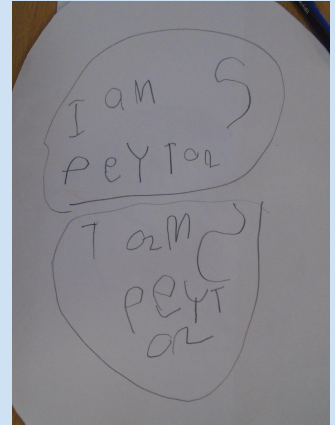
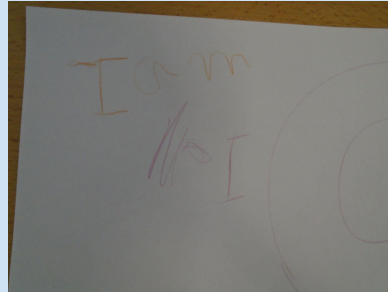
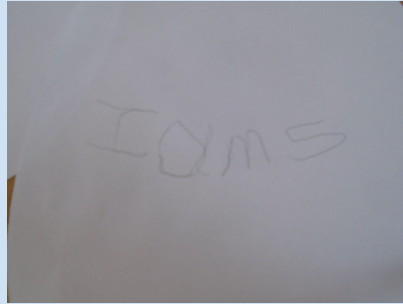
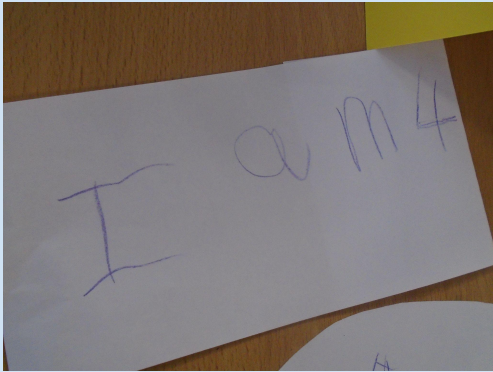
