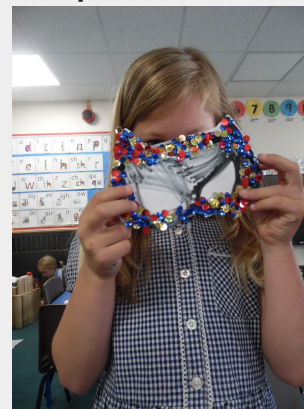
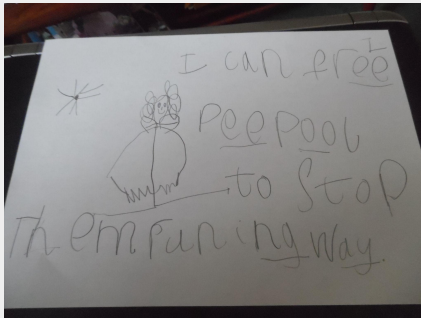


Cavalry Newsletter 11.07.2022
