## Maths

Here are some challenges all to do with fractions. Which ones can you do? Draw and use counters if you want to.

Draw these shapes. How many different ways can you shade one half of the shape?
Remember there are 6 squares - what is half of 6 ?


Can you work out this problem?
Alex and Jack are talking about quarters


My shape shows
quarters because
it has four parts.

Or this problem?
In the first square, show less than a quarter shaded.

In the next square, show exactly a quarter shaded.

On the last square, show more than a quarter shaded


Are they correct? Explain your answer.

This is a bit trickier - use counters or draw the hoops to help you.
