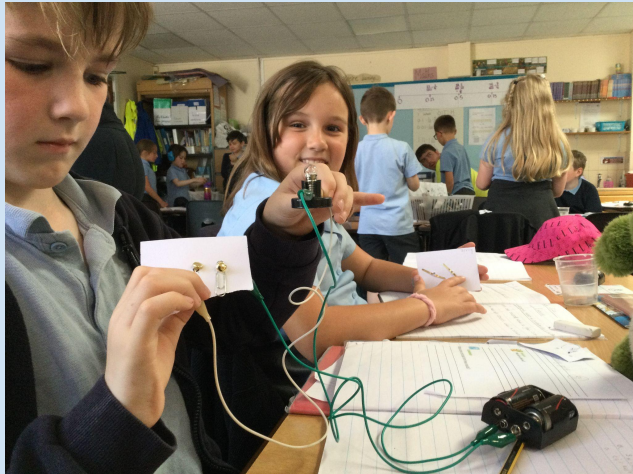

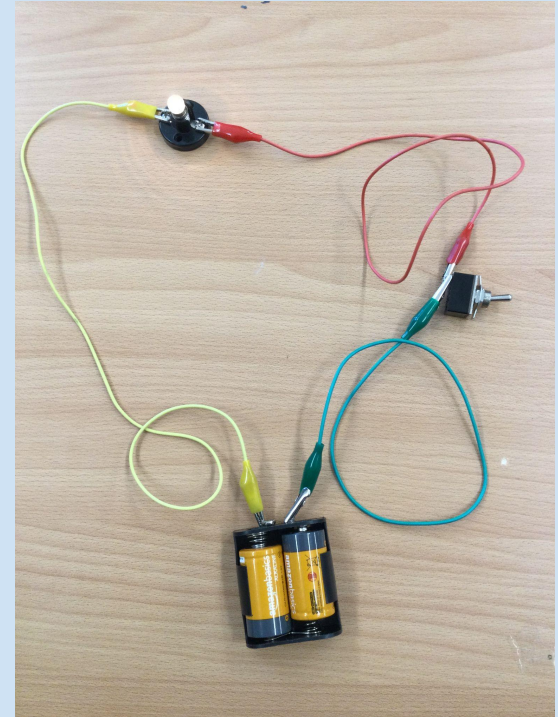


Last week in Year 4:

We finished learning about how to keep our teeth healthy and clean with a very enjoyable Nature Explorers session making clay faces with teeth on the trees. They all looked brilliant!



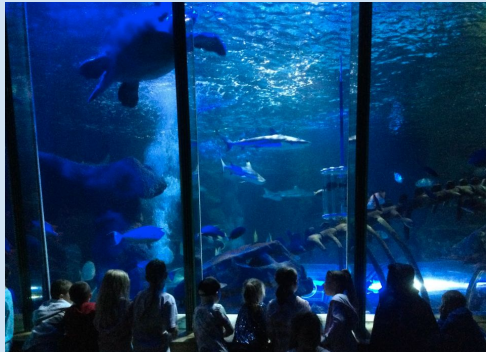
Best attendance last week: congratulations to Class 4 with 97% and Class 7 with 99%. Our whole school target is 97%.

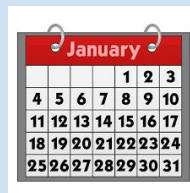
Our new shady area:
