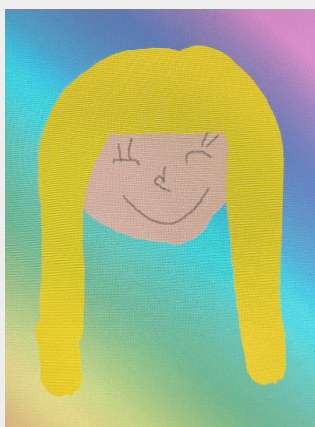


Cavalry Newsletter 28.02.2022
