#### ON THE DAY

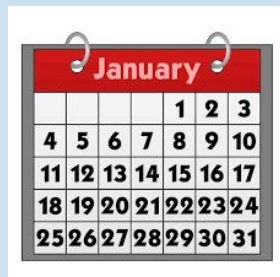
There will be refreshments, audience participation (join in on our own inner track as Jason runs the blue track), help him to celebrate at the finish line and join the family fun run at the end!
