We are learning about the lifecycle of a frog. The children are keeping an eye on the tadpoles in our tank, eager to spot the growth of legs! I wonder when that will be?

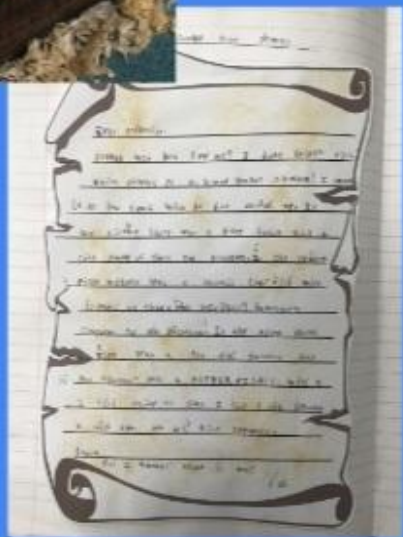
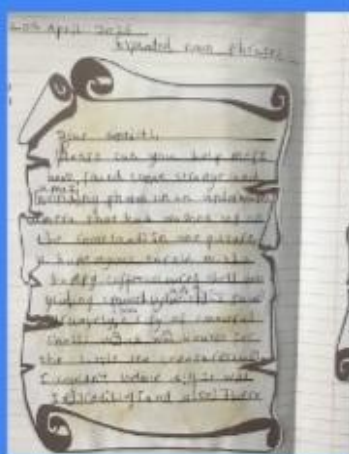
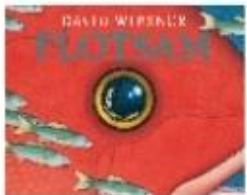


LEARNING IN ACTION...

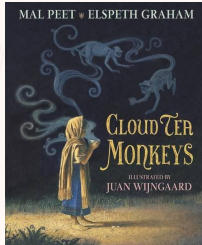

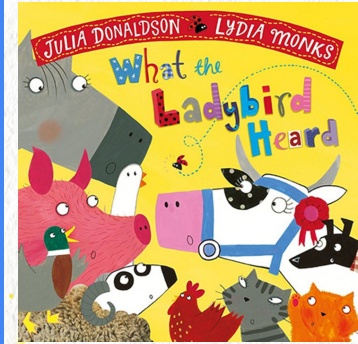

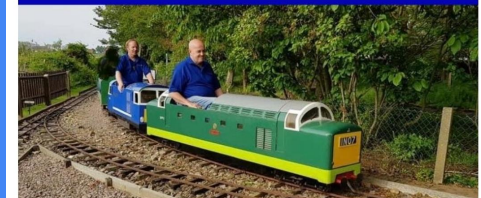
