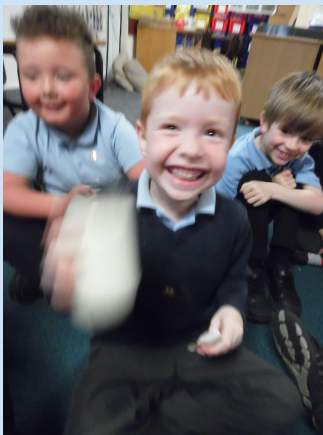

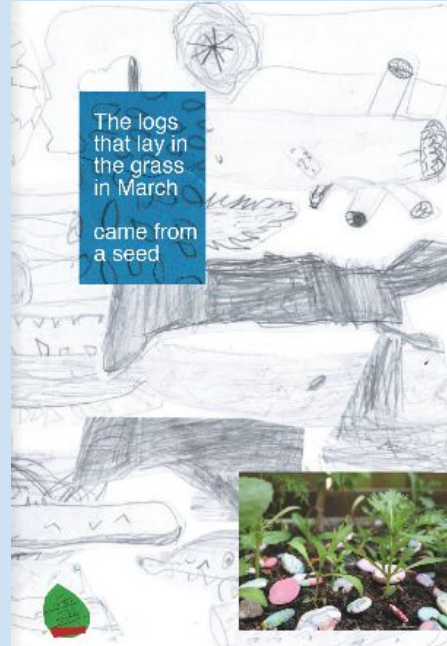
Last week in Year 3:

They've taken part in very various activities including writing, drawing and collaging, with all children having contributed something.

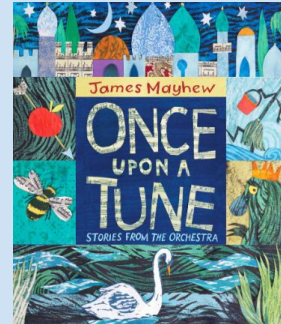
Year 3 parents keep your eyes peeled for an invite to come and see what they have created!

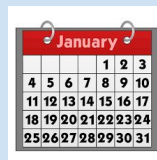
