<u>Maths</u>

Half of amounts

To find half of an amount you put your objects into 2 groups - you are splitting them into half.

The 2 groups must have the same amount of objects to make it equal.

I have 10 pencils and I split them into 2 groups. I have 5 in each group.





Half of 10 is 5.

What can you find to split into 2 groups - will the starting number be odd or even?

Find some objects and do the same with quarters. This time you need 4 equal groups. When we quarter we split into 4. Some numbers don't quarter very easily so try these starting numbers - 4,8,12,16,20. They are all multiples of 4.
