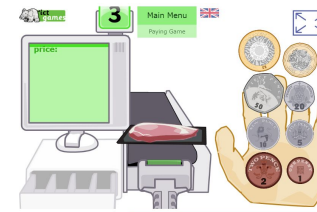
## Active Learning
