Dear Parents

Welcome back to school at the start of what will, I am sure, be a very busy and exciting school year. We hope that you have enjoyed the holidays but are glad to get back into the school routine. The children look so smart in their school uniforms and our Reception children have settled in so quickly on their very first day.

There will be an opportunity for all parents to visit the classrooms and meet the class teachers on Monday 16th and Tuesday 17th September so we hope to see many of you then. This is an opportunity to find out more about how your child will be taught in the coming year and ask any general questions you may have. It will not be easy for teachers to engage in detailed or confidential conversations at these meetings, so please make a separate appointment to see your child's class teacher if necessary. We will be offering parents our usual private appointment with their child's class teacher in November and again in March. Nursery parents will be offered appointments to meet with their child's key person during December.

At the November parents' meetings we will also be checking all of the details which we hold on file about contact names and addresses. It is vital that we hold accurate information so please do ensure that you let us know if you have changed a phone number or contact address over the summer. We must have a minimum of two emergency contacts for every child.

We are always very grateful for any offers of help from parents, as classroom helpers. If you are willing to give any time this year please fill in the slip at the bottom of this letter and you will be contacted by Mrs Stanforth shortly. Volunteer helpers are asked to provide two references and undergo a DBS check.

Please can I remind you that all of the Reception, Year 1 and Year 2 children will continue to be entitled to a free hot lunch every day this year but Year3/4/5 and 6 will be charged £2.30 per meal. All meals must be paid for in advance, preferably using ParentPay. If you are not able to access the internet via your phone, tablet or computer, we can set up a payment card for you to be used at any local shop with PayPoint – please ask in the school office. We also have a laptop you can use – just ask the office staff. Setting up your ParentPay account also enables us to send letters to you by email which saves the school money for photocopying and means we can send text messages should the school be closed by bad weather.

There is a list of dates for your diary attached to this letter, which gives an outline of what we are planning for the year ahead. Please enter these on your calendar now and we will contact you nearer the time of each event with further details.

Please can I also remind you that cars are not allowed to move on the entrance drive <u>or park</u> <u>in the bus bay</u> when children are entering and leaving school. This is essential for the health and safety of all of the children. Please park with due consideration for the residents near the school, as it is very frustrating for them if driveways are blocked or parents park dangerously close to junctions.

I would also like to remind you that parents must inform school if their child is not going to be attending school or nursery for any reason. Please telephone the office on the first day of absence or email us on admin@cavalryprimary.org If we have not heard from you and we cannot contact you by telephone, we may need to make a home visit to check that your child is safe. Please do remember that if you choose to take your child out of school for reasons other than sickness or medical appointments, the absence will not be authorised and may result in a fixed penalty notice from Cambridgeshire County Council. If you need to request a leave of absence during term time, a form is available from the school office.

Children in Year 1 through to Year 6 are bringing home a paper letter today, detailing all the **clubs and activities** offered this term at lunch time and after school. I am very grateful to all the teachers who give up their own time to run these clubs on a voluntary basis. If your child would like to join one or more of our clubs, please return the slip to the office by Wednesday 11th September. Once signed up, we expect children to attend the club each week so please let the class teacher know if your child has to miss a session.

We look forward to working with you all this year. Please remember that if you have any problems or queries, you are welcome to come in and see us, as we are always happy to do what we can to help you.

We ask all parents to avoid booking holidays during term time, but this is even more important during our statutory assessment periods. Year 6 sit their SATs in the week beginning 11th May 2020, which covers maths, reading and grammar. Their writing is continuously assessed throughout May and June. Year 2 sit their SATS (reading and maths) and their writing is continuously assessed during the whole of May. Year 1 phonics check takes place in the week beginning 8th June. It is essential for these year groups to be in school during these assessment periods.
