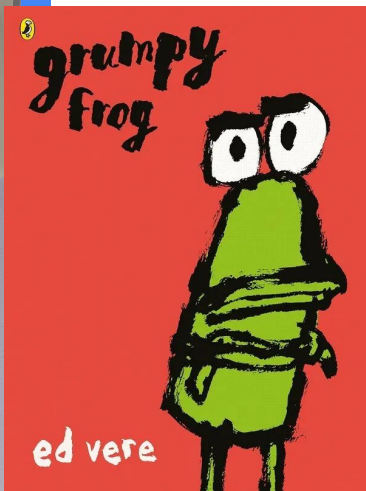
Grumpy Frog was not a good friend. He could be better

The children then wrote some suggestions about how Grumpy Frog could be a better friend.





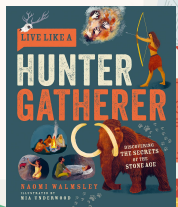

# Phonics!

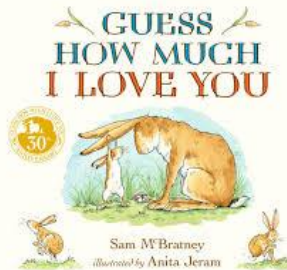


Well done to Mrs
