## Last week in Reception:

Reception became sunflower experts, learning what we need to grow sunflowers around our pond area. We now know that there are different types, colours and heights of sunflowers. We looked at the information on the seed packets and we saw a calendar showing when to plant them and when they will flower. We all enjoyed choosing a sunflower seed to plant and there were lots of suggestions as to why some seeds were white, some stripey and some black! We have created our own calendar and will keep checking our seeds for growth. We learned about a famous artist called Vincent Van Gogh. He loved to paint sunflowers, sometimes in a vase and sometimes in the fields. We saw how he often painted the background yellow and he created swirls with his brush and fine lines for petals. We were inspired to create our own masterpieces! We finished the week with our own immersive Van Gogh experience, laying on the floor and watching the images of Van Gogh's sunflowers as they danced around the ceiling to some wonderful classical music.



Last week in Year 4: Year 4 have continued to learn about states of matter by observing different materials at room temperature, frozen and when heated. We used foil cups, pegs and candles to heat the materials and recorded how they changed at different temperatures.
