Snacks at playtimes: In Reception, Year 1 and Year 2, children are provided with a piece of fruit to eat at morning break under a government funded scheme. From Year 3 upwards, we suggest that children bring in a piece of fruit/vegetable from home to help them keep going through the morning. This is especially important as we are no longer provided with bagels at the start of the day. The snack in KS2 must be a piece of fruit or suitable vegetable e.g carrot sticks so that we are following the government's food standard regulations. We don't allow children to eat fruit bars or cereal bars at snack time, as these contain added sugar.



This week in Year 3: Today, Year 3 investigated the rock cycle using Starburst sweets! First, they cut the sweets up into small pieces to make sediments. When the sweets were squashed together, they formed sedimentary rocks. Next, the children used the heat from their hands to shape and transform the rocks into metamorphic rocks. Finally, they used the microwave to turn the rocks into magma from a volcano! Once the magma had cooled and solidified, it formed igneous rocks.



Parking near school: A huge 'thank you' to all those families who are walking to school or parking safely at a distance from our gates. Along with some of the local residents, we have been in touch with the police to request regular visits to enforce the parking regulations in place near the school and ensure cars do not park on junctions. Just a reminder that a 'no waiting' sign with a single yellow line means you can't wait there during the times shown on the sign, even in order to drop passengers off.
