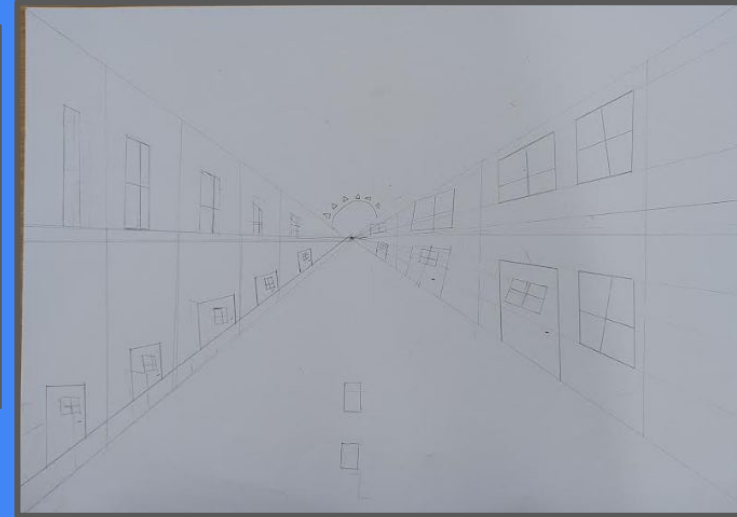
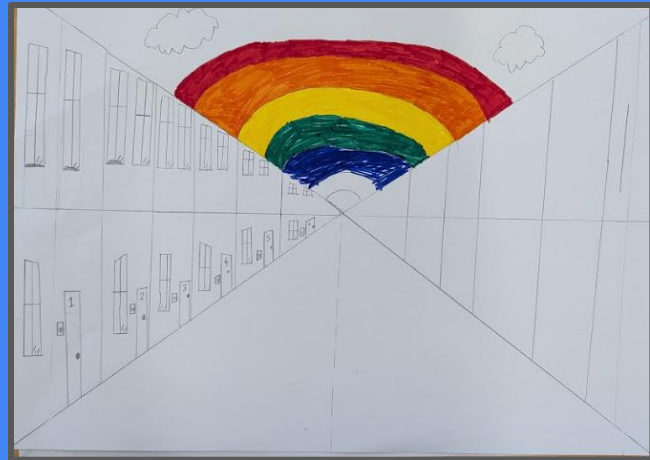


Year 1 have been busy making hibernation dens for a creature of their choice.

What can you do to support learning?

Sensory chew toys

Some children at Cavalry have been given permission for the use of a sensory chew toy/necklace. Whilst it is appropriate for a small minority of children, in a carefully managed and supported way, we are asking that children do not bring these to school without speaking to Mr Harris (SENDCo) first. The reason for this is because, if not managed correctly, they can:

- Increase oral fixation causing dental and jaw strain
- Collect bacteria and dirt causing oral infections
- Break off becoming a potential choking hazard

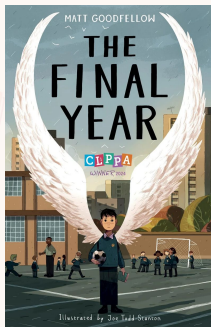
