

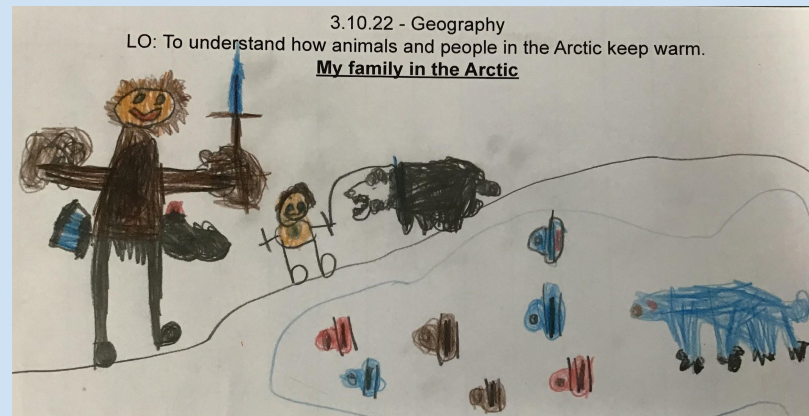


# Cavalry Newsletter 10.10.2022

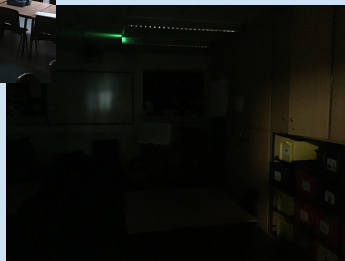


## Last week in Year 1:

This week in geography, we have looked at how animals and people in the Arctic keep warm. We learned about traditional clothing that Inuits wear such as parka, trousers and mittens made from caribou and seal skin.



In science, we discovered the difference between light from the sun and from street lights. We learnt the definitions of the words light, dim and dark. We explored the school and found areas that were light, dim and dark. Did you know the music room is really dark when you turn off all the lights!





## Last week in Year 6:

In Science, the children set up their own investigations to test how exercise affects their pulse rate. They timed themselves exercising for one minute then counted their pulse rate for another minute and repeated this activity.
