Fred says 'well done' to Year 2 who have been working hard during their comprehension sessions.



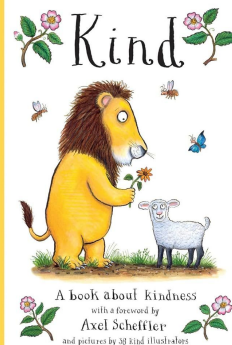
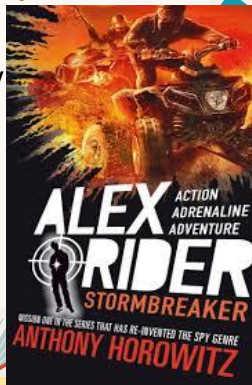
Miss Jones recommends...
