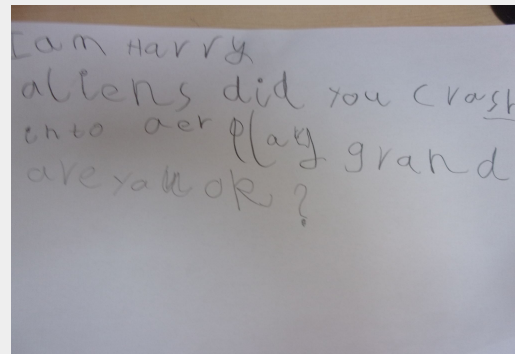


Cavalry Newsletter 17.05.2021
