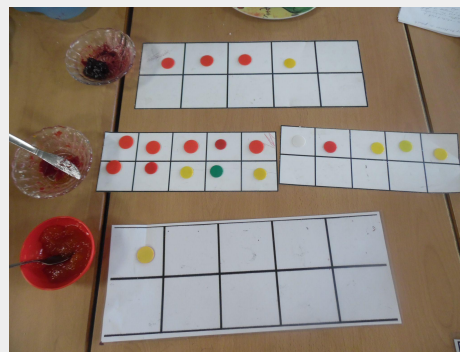


Cavalry Newsletter 28.3.2022

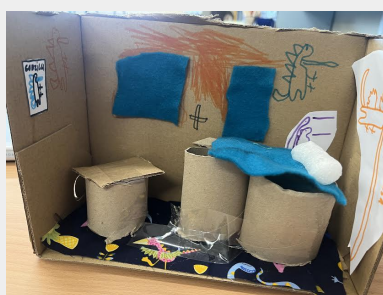

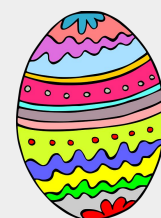
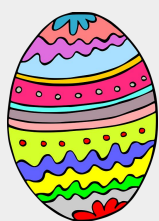
