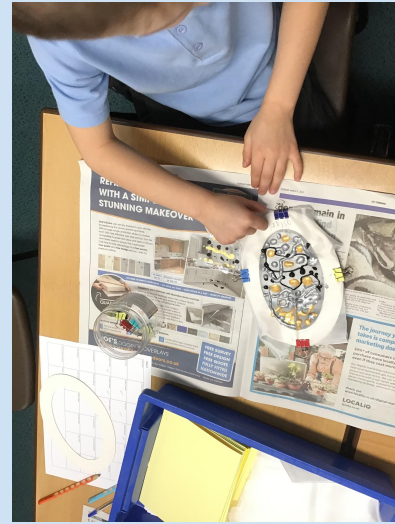
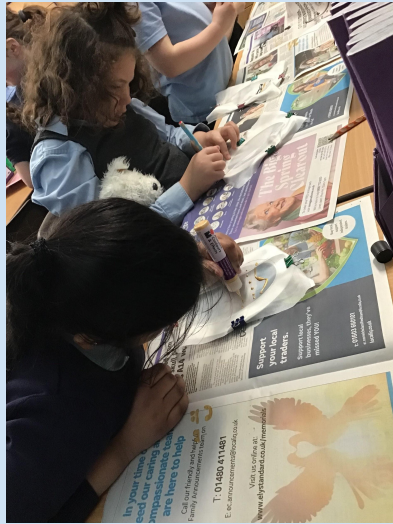


In Geography, the children worked on their map skills and learned about the symbols on OS maps. These skills might come in handy for those children visiting Wales this week!

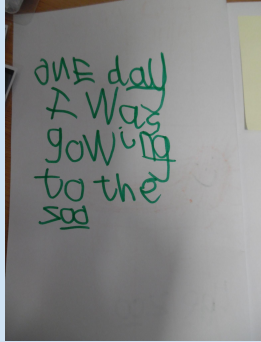
Best attendance last week: congratulations to Class 4 with 100% and Classes 8 with 95%. Our whole school target is 97%.



Last week in Reception:

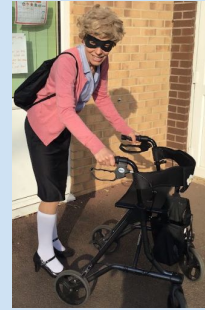

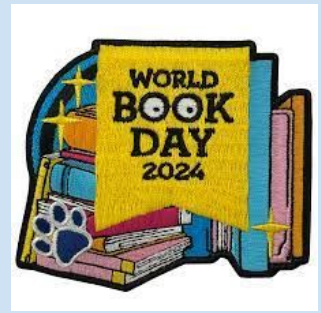




Year 4 in their fancy dress costumes.

This week the classes with the most 'words read' in Y4/5/6 were:

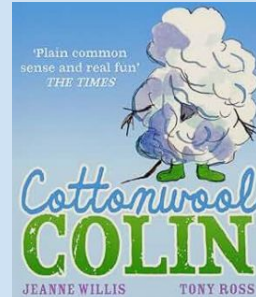

Fred says 'fantastic work!' to all the children in Mrs Wilson's group - you are really getting to grips with your Fred Talk!

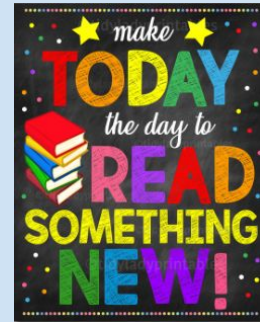
Brilliant Books:

Class 5 love this story. They often join in with Miss Boyd as she reads aloud their favourite phrases.



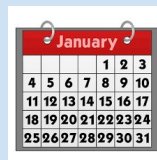
Have you read....?
