# LEARNING IN ACTION...

Nursery

We are learning about minibeasts and the patterns found in nature and on bugs in the garden. We've held snail races and created a snail terrarium so we can closely observe their habits. We made lettuce soup to find out how they eat. The children have been finding alternative ways to measure the growth of our sunflowers. They used wooden blocks to count how tall they are and measured the height of each other in comparison.



# LEARNING IN ACTION...

Year 6



In Year 6, children completed an investigation to measure shadows depending on the direction of light. The aim was to create shaded areas for sunbeds at a swimming pool facility. Children had to be aware of the direction of sunlight during different times in the day and how this impacts the size of the shadow.

They worked brilliantly as a team during these investigations.

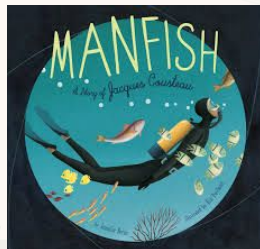

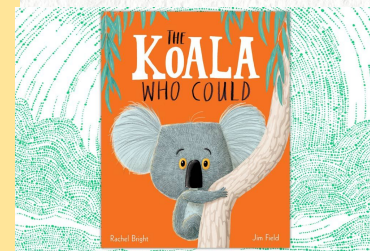


Fred says 'well done' to Mrs Banks' group who have been working hard when holding a sentence and remembering to try using finger spaces, a capital letter and a full stop!
