We challenged the children to build with unconventional materials to develop their critical thinking skills. The children used paper cups and lollipop sticks, coming up with some wonderful ideas for their constructions. They estimated how many cups they had used and checked by counting, using tape measures, rulers and spirit levels to compare constructions with their friends.
