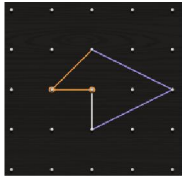


Good morning Year 1.

## Maths

We are going to look at irregular shapes today. Not every shape has the same length of sides - take a look!



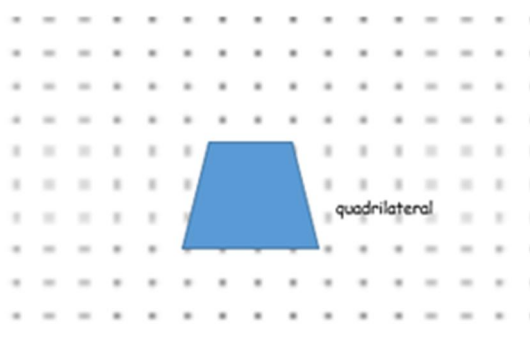
This is a 5 sided shape so it is a pentagon. All shapes with 5 sides is a pentagon.



This is a quadrilateral. All shapes with 4 sides are quadrilaterals but some, like squares and rectangles have special names as well.

These shapes are made on a geo board - you can find one at <https://apps.mathlearningcenter.org/geoboard/>. It's a bit fiddly at first and you will need to read the instructions carefully.

Instead, you could draw some dots on paper and join some dots to make irregular shapes. There is a page of dotted paper at the end of this email.
