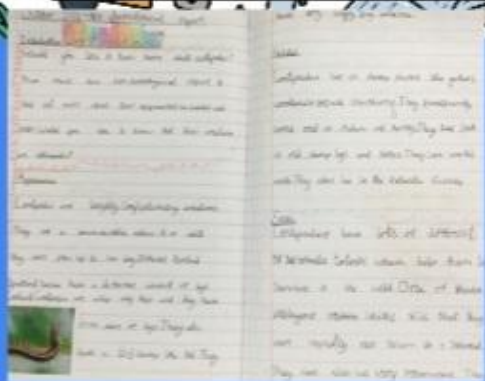
Whilst the soup was cooking away the children explored the inside of pumpkins and other vegetables.
