Kim's game

You will need a grown up or a brother or sister to play this game with you. A small group is even better. You could even try this on a video call, or play it outside.

Collect about 20 small items. Good ones are:

- Nail varnish bottle
- Tiny teddies
- Pencils
- Plastic jewellery
- Small value coins
- Fake bugs, beetles, spiders etc.

Place your objects around a tray. They should all be visible from a few feet away on either side

Tell people to look at the items. Set a time limit - say, a minute.(You could learn how to use a minute timer!)

Have a good look during that minute. Then put a sheet over the tray so the items are not visible

One person removes one item from the tray - make sure nobody is looking!

Remove the cloth - can you see which item has gone? Perhaps you can be the person to remove the item next time. For a challenge remove two items or change the minute to half a minute!!
