This week at Cavalry:

- It has been great to see our new Nursery and Reception children settling in, making new friends and enjoying playing outside in the sunshine.
- In Year 2, the children have been tasting lots of different fruits today. They had to look carefully at the colour and shape, then think about the texture and taste of each fruit. This will help them to design a fresh fruit salad of their own.
- Science in Year 4 this week has seen the children continuing to learn about how our digestive systems work. The children used orange juice mixed with bread to see how the acid in our stomachs breaks the food down.
- Year 6 have also had an exciting Science lesson today, making replica blood! Vegetable oil
 represented the plasma, cheerios took the place of red blood cells, mini marshmallows acted as
 white blood cells, and bread crumbs represented platelets. This practical activity had certainly
 helped the children to remember the function of each component of our blood.
