These writing units will run alongside weekly guided reading lessons on a range of fiction and non-fiction texts. 	 We will continue to use a range of methods to complete addition and subtraction calculations. After this, we will be working on our multiplication and division skills. This includes working hard to develop install recall of times tables facts up to 12 x 12 because this is fundamental skill which helps with maths in the future years.

 Read with your child, even if they are a fluent and confident reader, asking comprehension questions; there are example questions to guide you in the Y4 google classroom Encourage your child to read independently for sustained periods Learn weekly spellings through set activities (these are also set as homework in the Y4 google classroom) 	 Encourage your child to complete their weekly homework online: 15 minutes of Times Tables Rock Stars. 15 minutes on the Prodigy maths platform. Practise rapid recall of times tables and linked division facts. Use opportunities to tell the time in daily life. You will find a summary of the written calculation methods we teach in school in the Y4 google classroom.
