Best attendance last week: congratulations to Class 6 with 97.4% and Class 11 with 99.6%. Our whole school target is 97%.





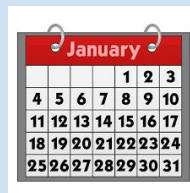
## Sport/PE page:
